

Camelbak ARC 4 hydration belt & ARC Quick Grip



CAMELBAK ARC 4 is a fantastic hydration belt. As the name implies there are 4 bottles that are evenly balanced. The belt is contoured to fit and shape to a waist without slipping awkwardly up or down. Camelbak has taken the jet valve system and put that on small hydration bottles that are excellent for running. The issue I have had with hydration belts is the bottle valve. I would find myself opening bottles, closing bottles, just to find out that the last one that I thought was closed was leaking down my leg. Camelbak has solved my complaint by putting the jet valve on the bottle. The jet valve can be sealed with a twist. When the valve is open you can suck or squeeze to get the flow. When the jet valve is open water does not leak unless you apply pressure. The ARC shape is so comfy that you won't feel the need to rush the bottle back to the belt. The waist belt has a zip pocket that can fit some gel or keys etc. The bottles can be switched out from a 6 ounce to the 10 oz. The belt is made out of very comfortable mesh and the belt fastens with velcro allowing for optimal adjustment. If you are looking for a goo hydration belt the ARC 4 is a great option just make sure you get the right size.

ARC QUICK GRIP

This is the best hand-held hydration I have ever used. I have tried to run with the traditional water bottle. I even tried the Quick grip that goes on the Podium chill. I felt really off balance. My hand was shaped unnaturally to carry the bottle. The ARC is shaped like my hand, I feel balanced. Yes, it is only 10 ounces and if I need more I will take the hydration belt. The ARC QUICK GRIP has a mesh strap that is adjustable to your hand and fits comfortably. With a strip of mesh between the palm and the bottle the grip doesnt slip and there is a nice pocket that can fit keys, or a couple GUs.
