


CamelBak Arc Quick Grip™ run bottle review

The CamelBak Arc Quick Grip™ run bottle is contoured to hug your hand to make hydrating fast and easy while you're running. A lightweight breathable strap helps keep the bottle in place, and there's a pocket to store your keys, cash, gels or phone. CamelBak also included reflective elements for better visibility while running at night.

A 10-ounce Podium Arc bottle is included with

the Arc Quick Grip and the self-sealing Jet Valve™ eliminates splatters and spills. The bottle is BPA-free and has TruTaste™ Polypropylene with HydroGuard™ so you can actually taste the water and not the bottle. There's also a lockout for leak-proof transport.

The CamelBak Arc Quick Grip definitely contoured nicely to the hand when putting it on. It felt sturdy and the fact that there wouldn't be any hassle with a loose bottle while trail running made quite a difference. The stowaway pocket was extremely useful to hold the car keys and a couple of snacks/gels.

The self-sealing Jet Valve™ was great in that you could either squeeze the water out into your mouth or suck it out like a straw and then you didn't have to worry about re-sealing the bottle afterwards. There were absolutely no problems with leaking or spilling.

There were actually times where I forgot I had the Arc Quick Grip around my hand while running, and it wasn't until I realized I needed a drink that it was still on my hand. Everything stayed in place, and the pocket kept my belongings safe.

Convenience is a good way to describe how the Arc Quick Grip is. If you love to run with as minimal of a hydration item as possible, the Arc Quick Grip is perfect. As uncomplicated as it is screwing a cap back on a water bottle, it was just so nice not having to worry about that as well as spilling the water all over your face while trying to run and drink at the same time. The CamelBak Arc Quick Grip is simple to use, lightweight and durable, and is highly recommended for your shorter runs.
